St. Lawrence County Community Services Department is in search of:

Registered Physician's Assistant (Part Time)

Salary: Commensurable with experience

Acts as a member of the health care team by performing delegated medical tasks and services appropriate to the employing/supervising physician's field of practice; does related work as required. This work involves responsibility for assisting the physician by performing basic medical services, procedures and tasks. Many medical procedures traditionally performed by a physician are not of a complexity to require that the physician always perform them personally; a major purpose of persons employed in the title of Physician's Assistant is to free the time of the physician for duties requiring his professional medical attention. Work is performed under the direction and supervision of a physician who is licensed and currently registered to practice in New York State.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Completion of a program for the education and training of Physician's Assistants or its equivalent, approved by the New York State Education Department and current registration as a physician's Assistant by the New York State Education Department.

NOTE: Standards as prescribed by Section 700.2 (b) (28) and Part 707 of the New York State Hospital Code; Part 94 (Section 94.1 and 94.2) of Title 10 (Health) of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York; and Section 60.8 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education.

Additional Information about this Opening:

A DEA DATA 2000 Waiver to prescribe Buprenorphine would be required within six (60) days of employment. The prescriber provides low-barrier buprenorphine-based medication assisted treatment (MAT) to individuals with opioid use disorder at St. Lawrence County Chemical Dependency Clinics, including provision of medical intake, buprenorphine induction, stabilization, and maintenance care. This is a position for a dynamic provider in a high-paced outpatient clinic setting with a focus on behavioral healthcare Medication Assisted treatment. A portion of the direct service provision could be done remotely via telepractice. The successful candidate will have a 100 x-waiver required/275 x-waiver preferred as well as a strong interest in working in mental health and substance abuse services, as exhibited by previous work experience. The ideal candidate would have the knowledge and skills to provide prevention, screening, intervention and treatment related to substance use disorders.

In order to be permanently appointed for this position, you must be appointed from a civil service exam list. This exam is a Training and Experience Exam. You will not be required to sit for a written exam. You will be scored based on an evaluation of your education and experience as shown on your resume/application.
