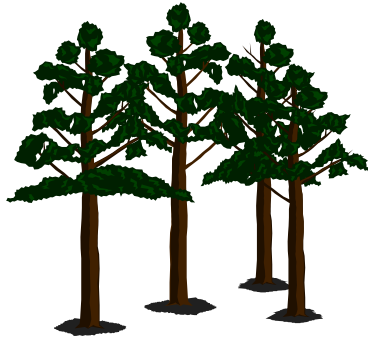


WHIPPORWILL CORNERS TRAIL SYSTEM

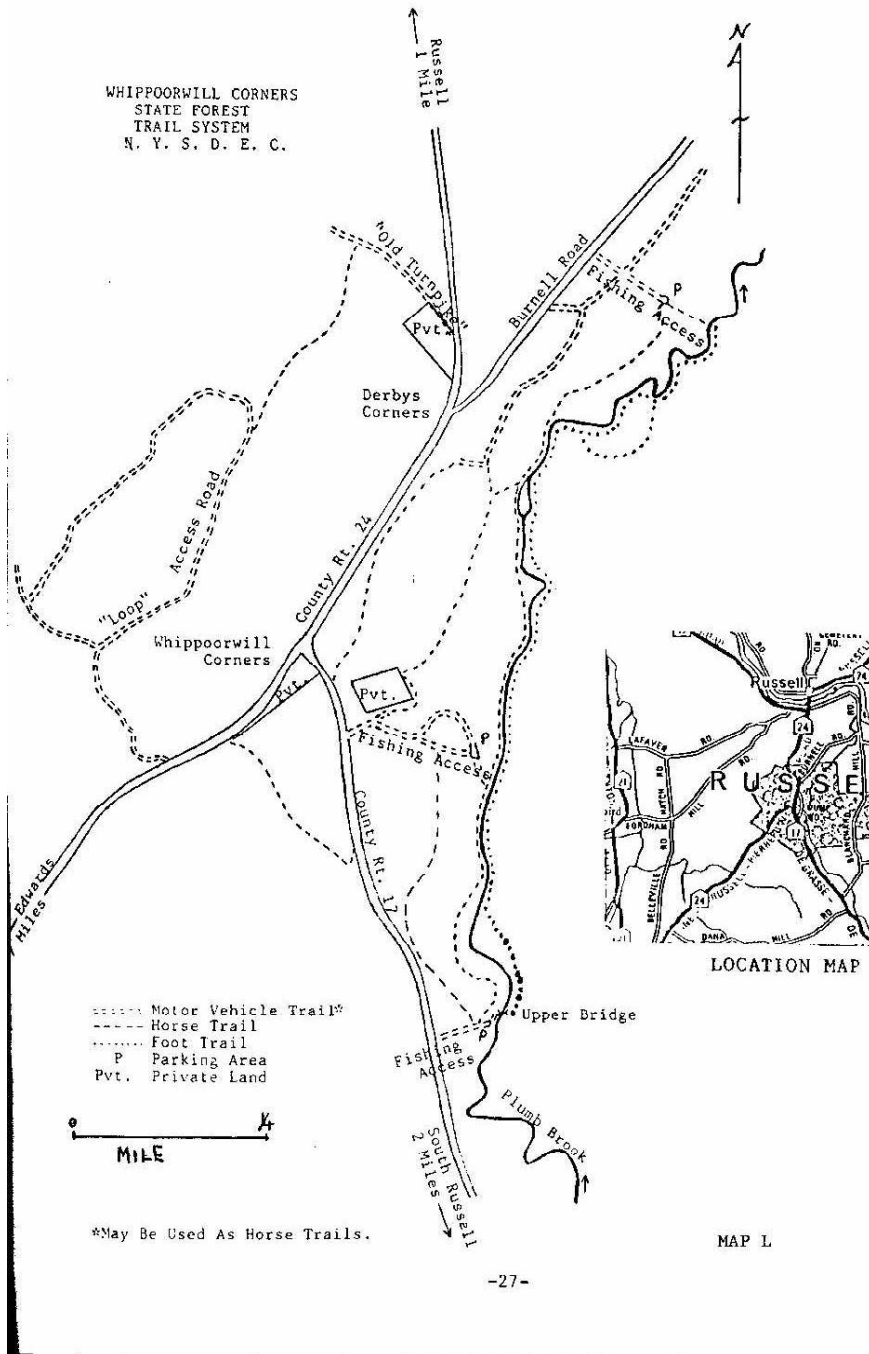
These trails are located one mile south of the Village of Russell on Whipporwill Corners State Forest. The 0.9 mile Plumb Brook trail follows Plumb Brook, a popular fishing stream.

There are several entrances to the trail system. The Plumb Brook trail can be entered off the Burnell road, which is close to the Edwards-Russell road (County road 24). There is a parking area on the East Side of the road. The trail then leads to the DeGrasse-Russell road (county road 17) at which point the trail may also be entered.

Many new trails have been added to this system. Several of these trails are suitable for horses.
